Note 2.—Question No. 17 will only be asked in cases where an affirmative answer has been given either in question 10 or in question 11.  
Note 3.—Question No. 14 will only be asked in cases where a paid occupation had been reported in column 13.  
Note 4.—In column 7 an abbreviation in the course of the month may be used, as Jan., Apr., Dec.
