

ADMINISTRATOR'S BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY.

Whereas, Wm S Collins
has been appointed, by the County Court of Letcher County, Administrator
of Stephen Roberts deceased, intestate:

Now We, Wm S Collins Administrator and
J. M. Blair & R. B. Day
sureties, do hereby covenant to and with the Commonwealth of Kentucky,
that the said Wm S Collins will
well and truly administer the goods, chattels, credits, and effects of the said
intestate, according to law, and will further make a just and true account
of all his actings and doings therein; and will well and
truly make a proper distribution of any surplus money, effects and rents
which may come to his hands, or to any one for him by color of
his office, to the persons entitled thereto. If it shall hereafter appear
that a last Will and Testament was made by the deceased, and the same
be proved and recorded, we further covenant that the said Wm S
Collins will, in such case, surrender his
letters of administration; and that he will account with, and pay
and deliver over to the Executor or Administrator with the Will
annexed, the assets in his hands unadministered.
