

Deed
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This Indenture made the 11th day of July in the year of our Lord 1839 between Philip Rappin Dequinn and Philip Rappin Junior of Orange County Virginia, Witnesseth for and consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars current money of this Commonwealth to the said Philip Rappin Dequinn in hand paid before seeing and delivering here presents the receipt whereof the said Philip Rappin Dequinn doth hereby acknowledge that the giving buying granting and conveying and confirming in fee to the said Philip Rappin Junior a certain parcel or tract of land containing fifty acres, be the same more or less, lying in the County of Orange on the waters of Buffalo Creek and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a white oak, not oak, and chestnut oak, and John Parks line near a path from thence on north corner along said path a meridional line to a chestnut from thence S 20. degrees poles to a stake S 15 1/2 poles to a stake S 77. 1/2 poles to a white oak his former corner S 27. 1/2 W 100 poles to two white oaks S 4 1/2 to the same line and including all of said tract and all of the 43 acre tract past to the above mentioned lands with all privileges and appurtenances to said Philip Rappin Junior his heirs forever to have and to hold to their heirs forever in the opinion of our persons the said Philip Rappin Dequinn doth agree and consent with the said Philip Rappin Junior and his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever. with warrant and of avow of feoffment the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Philip Rappin Junior his heirs and assigns forever.
