sum of One hundred and fifty dollars; to which payment well and truly to be  
made to the said Governor for the time being, and to his successors in office, for  
the use of the Commonwealth, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly and se-  
verally, by these presents. Witness our hands and seals this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of  
October 1830

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that whereas the above  
bound Alexander Cornutt hath this day obtain-  
ed from the Clerk's Office of Grayson County a License for his marriage with  
Genama Rudy Daughter of Stephen Rudy  
of said county. If therefore there be now no lawful cause to obstruct said mar-  
riage then the above obligation to be void.
