

CERTIFICATE TO OBTAIN A MARRIAGE LICENSE.

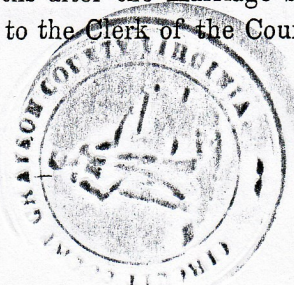
