Esq. Governor of Virginia, for the time being, and to his successors for the use of the Commonwealth, in the sum of One Hundred and Fifty dollars, to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor for the use of the Commonwealth, we bind ourselves our heirs &c. jointly and severally firmly by these presents: Witness our hands and seals, this *28* day of *august* 1822

THE condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above bound *Joseph Bonham* hath this day obtained from the Clerks Office of Grayson County, a license for his MARRIAGE with *Tabitha Russell* Daughter of *Phillip Russell* of said County. If therefore, there be no lawful cause to obstruct said Marriage, then the above obligation to be void.
