SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, That every Justice of the Peace, Minister of the Gospel, and all other legally authorized persons solemnizing marriages in this State shall make a record of each marriage so solemnized by him, together with all the facts relating to the same, as required by the 5th section of this act; and such Justice, Minister of the Gospel, or other person shall, at the time such marriage is solemnized, deliver on demand to either of the parties so joined in marriage as aforesaid a certificate of such marriage, containing all the facts in relation thereto required by said 5th section of this act, and shall within thirty days thereafter deliver to the Clerk of the County Court in which such marriage took place a certified copy of such record.—Act of 1881.
