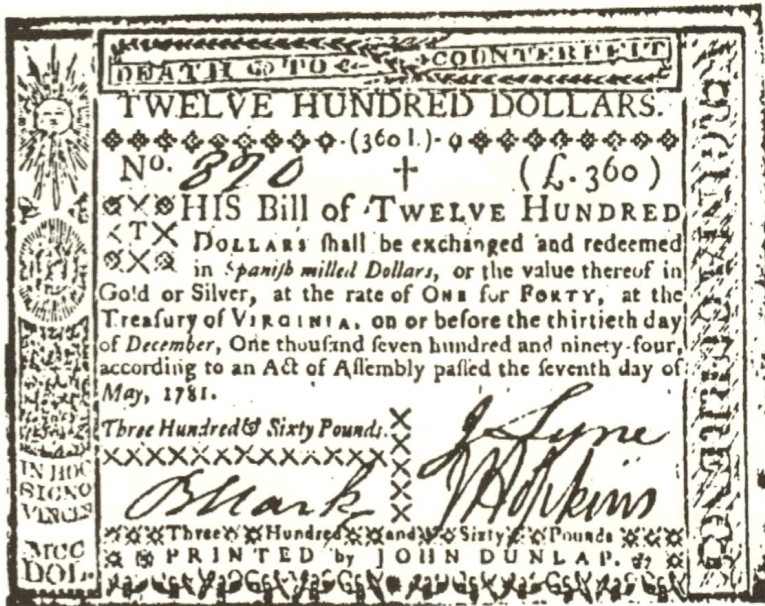

TITLE PAGE: A Virginia Revolutionary note of \$1200 (£360) authorized by act of the Virginia Assembly on May 7, 1781. Printed in denominations from \$10 to \$2,000, this was the fifteenth (and last) set of notes issued since the Revolution first began. [Six months later, all notes were to be called in at a redemption of \$1 specie for \$1000 in bills, and all Virginia notes were to become worthless by October 1, 1791.]
