The 37th Battalion Virginia Cavalry (also known as Dunn's Battalion Partisan Rangers) was organized about August 2, 1862. Company B was composed of former members of the 4th Regiment South Carolina Infantry. Company F of North Carolinians, and Company K was formerly Captain Pack's Company, 1st Regiment Virginia Cavalry. Company H was transferred to Swann's Battalion Virginia Cavalry by S. O. No. 130, Hdqrs. Dept. W. Va. and E. Tenn., dated December 28, 1864.
